


Star Valley Hotel, Afton WY, about 1900 -- Run by Nels J. & Ingry Christopherson Family

The horse-thief stole Orson's horses while he was out on his trap-line. Upon returning to camp, Orson realized his horses were missing and tracked the horse-thief to the Deadman area. Thus, the naming of the Deadman Creek. Check out the gun, it was the one that did the shooting, according to Doris and her family. Probably in the late 1880's or 1890's.






Homecoming Parade on Afton's Main Street - 1940


